GREETING, WELCOME and ANNOUNCEMENTS Alleluia! Christ is risen! **Christ is risen, indeed! Alleluia!** This is the day the Lord has made; **let us rejoice and be glad in it.**

Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
