

ORGANIST/ACCOMPANIST JOB DESCRIPTION

- Beulah Presbyterian Church (6704 Bardstown Road, Louisville) seeks a part-time Organist/Accompanist to fill a renewable 1-year term. The Organist has the following responsibilities:
- Serve as member of the pastoral ministry team of Beulah Presbyterian Church.
- If the schedule permits, serve as a member of the Fellowship & Worship Commission, ex-officio.
- Work cooperatively, under the supervision of the Director of Music. Work cooperatively with the Pastor, who supervises all church staff.
- In cooperation with the Director of Music, lead in worship on the organ and/or piano during Sunday worship services. Currently there is one Sunday morning service at 10:30 am.
- Lead in worship from the organ and piano during holy day worship services, including Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday.
- Rehearse with the Chancel Choir on Wednesday evenings (typically late August through May) as well as any special rehearsals. [*No choir as of yet, due to COVID-19*].
- In cooperation with the Director of Music, arrange for substitute organist for vacation and/or make use of the MIDI in the organ to record the needed organ music and arrange for a choir member to use this device on the vacation Sunday.
- Inform the Director of Music regarding any needed organ repairs and piano tuning.
- In cooperation with the Director of Music, lead in worship for scheduled weddings. The Director of Music and/or Church Organist shall have the "First Right of Refusal" for all weddings in the church. Stipend for this to be paid by the wedding couple or family according to the current Wedding Policy.
- Lead in worship for any scheduled funerals; stipend for this to be made through the funeral director.
- Other opportunities for music leadership may be available.
